## Scene 1

Amelia and Asia pass Manufaktura Square on the right. At the same time, Gosia and Wojtek come out on the left. They meet each other by chance. They give each other a high-five .....

Wojtek: Oh hey, nice to see you! What are you doing here?

Asia: We've just come back from shopping.

Gosia: It's good because we've just finished doing shopping too.

Amelia: Let's hang out together?

Wojtek: Great idea!

Asia: Maybe we will go to Piotrkowska?

Gosia: Great!

## Scene 2

A group of friends has already found their way to Piotrkowska. They are walking, talking and laughing. There are historical tenement houses characteristic of Łódź around them. Asia and Amelka show Gosia and Wojtek, who came from Krakow, the famous Piotrkowska Street in Łódź. We visit the whole street along to Plac Wolności (Liberty Square).

Asia: Look, here is the Rose Passage. The facades of the buildings are covered with tiny pieces of mirrors laid out in irregular shapes. This place is extremely special. And the person behind this unique project is Joanna Rajkowska and her very personal story. In 2012 Joanna's daughter Rose fell ill with eye cancer and the installation is an expression of the artist's joy at the news of her daughter's recovery.

Wojtek: I like it very much, it looks awesome! I would like to live here! (We go further)

Amelia: Look, and here is the Walk of Stars. On the pavement you can see Polish cinema legends, for example Cezary Pazura, he is a famous polish actor.

Asia: Look, here is Freedom Square. It is the central square in Łódź. There is a statue of polish freedom fighter Tadeusz Kosciuszko.

Gosia: WOW! One street and so many interesting monuments!

Wojtek: We have to come back, will you walk us to the train?

Amelia: Yes, we will also show you the most modern railway station in Poland.

## Scene 3

Gosia, Asia, Amelia and Wojtek are at the railway station (Łódź fabryczna).

Gosia: It makes an impression!

Wojtek: Wow! It is the most modern railway station I have ever seen!

Gosia: We have to go now. Thank You for all and see you next time!

Wojtek: Yes, we will definitely come here again. Łódź is cool!
